

CAD Standards – Text Styles Standards

To maintain consistency, please follow the following guidelines for Text Style usage.

Attached is the list of standard layers and standard text styles to be used at Lanc & Tully. Other layers and text styles may appear within the drawings for various reasons but you should try to utilize these whenever practicable.

Recommended usage is as follows:

Bold – Road name labels, Notes heading, Match lines, Detail/Section titles, Profile titles, Zone table heading, etc.

Cont-lbl – Labels for existing and proposed contours.

Pl-text – Property line text.

Stalbl – Stationing of road centerline.

Text – Existing condition text.

Pr-Spot – Proposed spot elevations in site grading.

Pr-Text – Proposed condition text.

Additional Styles:

Standard – Default text style in AutoCAD

Romans – Used in the title blocks

Romand – Used in the title blocks

Romant – Used in the title blocks

I – Used in the north arrow for italics
